PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

SARAH GARDNER - Grove City College

5-10 Senior Middle Hitter

Gardner earned PAC Player of the Week honors for the second time this season after averaging 3.0 kills per game (33 total) and 5.82 digs per game (64 total) in 11 games as Grove City went 2-1 in three matches, including PAC wins over Thiel and Washington & Jefferson.

Also nominated was sophomore outside hitter **Katie Crutchfield** of Bethany, sophomore setter **Tiffany Snyder** of Thiel, and junior outside hitter **Jessica Dott** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

At 9-10, Bethany is hoping to record its first .500 season in Head Coach **Jan Forsty**'s eight-year tenure ... Sophomore **Katie Critchfield** pounded out a season-high 19 kills in the W&J victory ... The 5-11 outside hitter has recorded double-digits in kills in four of the last five matches ... Setter **Caci Iwaniec** had 39 assists in the W&J victory.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J dropped both of its PAC contests at home this past week to finish its four-game homestand at 2-2 ... Junior outside hitter **Jessica Dott**, last week's PAC Player of the Week, continued her steady play by totaling 31 kills in the two losses ... Dott amassed a team season and personal career-high 17 kills in the loss to GCC ... Sophomore outside hitter **Dana Wright** added 16 kills and 24 digs ... Wright also posted five aces against Grove City.

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines secured the top seed at the 2001 PAC Championship Tournament which will be hosted by Thiel College on Oct. 26-27 ... The Lady Wolverines will be seeking their second straight league crown ... Junior **Katie Summers** averaged 3.45 kills and posted a .291 hitting percentage in three matches last week ... Junior **Cara Denniston** averaged 11.27 assists in the 11-game span, while senior **Julie Porter** averaged 6.09 digs ... Junior **Kirsten Pedersen** recorded the game-winning kill in the fifth game at W&J last Thursday. It was the team's first five-set match of the season.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg posted a 1-2 week, dropping contests to Westminster (3-0) and PAC rival Thiel (3-1) before topping non-conference West Liberty State (3-1).

Thiel Tomcats

The Lady Cats earned their second victory of the 2001 season on October 11 with a huge PAC win over Waynesburg 3-1 (31-29, 30-25, 23-30, 30-27) ... Thiel sophomore setter **Tiffany Snyder** totaled a season-high 50 assists, while junior outside hitter **Tami Hassell** had 31 attacks with 16 kills and 4 errors.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster volleyball team posted a perfect 3-0 record last week, as the Lady Titans topped PAC opponents Waynesburg (3-0) and Bethany (3-0) at home, before posting a road win at Allegheny (3-1) ... Junior **Carolee Reed** set up 118 assists in the three wins ... **Suzanne Fitz** and **Shannon Simmons** posted 14 and 10 kills, respectively, vs. Waynesburg ... Simmons and **Katie Spehar** had 11 and 10 kills, respectively, against Bethany ...
