Washington & Jefferson Earns Top Seed, Hosting Rights for 2009 PAC Baseball Tournament

WEXFORD, Pa. - Washington & Jefferson College has earned the top seed and hosting rights for the 2009 PAC Baseball Championship Tournament, scheduled for Thursday-Saturday, May 7-9 beginning at noon each day at Ross Memorial Park in Washington, Pa.

The Presidents (28-11, 13-5 PAC) of seventh-year head coach **Jeff Mountain** will host fourth-seed and defending PAC champion Grove City (16-17, 9-9 PAC) in the opening round of the four-team, double-elimination tournament Thursday at 3 p.m. The other opening round contest will be between second seed Thomas More (28-10-1, 12-6 PAC) and third seed Thiel (26-12, 12-6 PAC) at noon

The 2009 PAC Baseball Tournament champion will receive an automatic bid to the 2009 NCAA Division III National Tournament, scheduled to begin the weekend of May 13-16, 2009 at a site TBA.

Admission for all three PAC baseball tournament dates is \$5 for adults, \$2 for students and \$1 for programs. PAC regular season passes are not accepted for PAC Tournament games.
