Bethany Bison

The Bison played in just one contest last week after having Wednesday's home game against Frostburg State postponed due to flooding in the Bethany area ... The game will be played on Thursday, Sept. 30, at 4 p.m. The Bison were able to play at home against Wilmington on Saturday and lost by a score of 5-1. Bethany has now lost four consecutive games after starting the season 4-0. Bethany's goal came from sophomore **John Zervos**, his first points of the season.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents snapped their four-match losing streak by posting wins over Penn State-Altoona and Waynesburg last week ... Sophomore MF **Mike Seminerio** scored a pair of goals in the win over the Lions ... Junior MF **Andrew Enrietti** gave W&J a 1-0 advantage in the third minute as he headed home a free kick from senior F **Mike Chiodo** ... Seminerio made it a 2-0 game in the 54th minute and then closed out the Lions on a free kick with four minutes left ... Senior GK **Mike Garet** made eight saves to earn the win ... Senior forward **Andy Komar** netted all three W&J goals in a 3-2 victory over Waynesburg in the PAC opener for the Presidents ... Chiodo assisted on all three goals and Garet made four saves.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines were blanked twice last week, including a 2-0 loss Saturday at Westminster in Grove City's first PAC road match of the year ... Goalkeeper **Joel Gladfelter** made six saves against Westminster after stopping five shots against Penn State Behrend Wednesday ... Saturday's match at Westminster started a four-game stretch away from home for the Wolverines ... Grove City visits Bethany Monday, then travels to Thiel Wednesday afternoon ... Six of Grove City's final seven matches are at home ... Seven of Grove City's eight matches have been shutouts this year, with Grove City winning four of those matches.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Conference play continues to give Waynesburg trouble, as the Yellow Jackets were unsuccessful in both PAC games this week, losing to W&J (3-2) and Thiel (3-1) ... In both losses Waynesburg gave up a hat trick to an opposing player ... Thus far this season the Jackets have been outscored 11-3 in three conference games ... Junior **Luke Benton** and freshman **Michael Wilson** combined to net three goals for the Jackets ... Against W&J, the Jackets held the Presidents scoreless in the first half and came back from a two-goal deficit to even the score at 2-2 before the Presidents netted the game-winning goal in the final 10 minutes ... The Tomcats limited the Jackets to five shots, with Benton scoring the lone goal of the game for Waynesburg.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats are currently riding the program's first three-game win streak after posting a 3-1 PAC victory over Waynesburg on Saturday ... Freshman F **Nikola Vasilev** had a hat trick as the Tomcats had to battle back from an early 1-0 deficit ... Freshman GK **Ryan Lewis** notched his third win of the year, recording three saves ... Freshman F **Josh Kwolek** assisted on two of Vasilev's three goals ... Thiel plays host to a pair of PAC rivals this week, taking on Grove City Wednesday (1 p.m.) and Westminster Sunday (3 p.m.).

Westminster Titans

Westminster rolled to a perfect 9-0 on the season, continuing the best start in school history with a pair of wins last week at Pitt-Greensburg (4-3) and at home vs. PAC foe Grove City (2-0) ...
