## Bethany Bison

BC lost their first two PAC games of the season by identical 1-0 scores ... Bethany lost a hard-fought one-goal game at W&J Wednesday, as a President score with 14 minutes to play was the difference ... W&J held an 11-4 advantage in shots, but GK **Kosta Floros** made four saves to keep the Bison close ... A late goal was the difference again when Bethany battled Grove City Saturday, as the Wolverines scored with two minutes left in the second OT ... A rebound off a corner kick allowed GCC to come away with the win ... Freshman **Chad Perry** made his first start in goal and stopped eight shots ... The Bison need wins in their final two games (home matches against W&J and Westminster), and a little help to get the top seed for next week's PAC Tournament.



## Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats posted an 0-3 mark last week ... Thiel opened the week with a 2-1 overtime loss at Westminster on Monday before losing at Penn State Behrend 2-0 Tuesday and at home to W&J 6-2 Saturday ... Against the Titans sophomore **Nikola Vasilev** scored on a penalty kick to even things at 1-1 in the 86th minute to force overtime ... The goal was Vasilev's team-high sixth of the season ... Sophomore GK **Ryan Lewis** had eight saves in the loss.



## Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson, which has won 10 of its last 11 contests, posted a 1-0 victory over Bethany on Wednesday to take over sole possession of first place ... Sophomore MF **Marc Clayton** scored with 14 minutes remaining to give W&J the win ... Junior MFs **Mike Seminerio** and **Brian Witkovitz** assisted on the goal ... Freshman GK **Tyler Hodgins** made one save to earn his fifth shutout in six games ... Seminerio scored a pair of goals at Thiel Saturday as W&J cruised to a four-goal triumph ... Freshman MF **Stephen Fant** and Witkovitz both added a goal and an assist, while sophomore D **Zach Williams** notched two helpers.



## Westminster Titans

Westminster went 2-1 last week, posting PAC wins over Thiel (2-1 in OT) and Waynesburg (5-1) before falling to non-league foe Carnegie Mellon (3-0) ... Junior F **Mark Sadler** scored the game-winning goal two minutes into overtime against the Tomcats, assisted by freshman D **Chris Ellwanger** ... Freshman MF **Max Irwin** had given the Titans a 1-0 lead off a **Chris Dymond** assist ... Junior GK **Anthony Beilstein** made two saves against the Tomcats ... Junior F **Blake Ordell** posted a hat trick with three goals while Sadler added two in the win over the Yellow Jackets ... Five different Titans posted assists: Dymond, juniors **Todd Atwood** and **Alex Castillo**, and sophomores **Andy Saporito** and **Keith Little** ... Beilstein made four saves.



## Grove City Wolverines

Grove City stayed in the race for home-field advantage in the PAC Tournament Saturday with a 1-0 double-OT victory at Bethany ... Junior B **Stuart McCommas** scored in the 108th minute off a corner kick ... Junior B **Brendan McCommas**, Stuart's twin brother, provided the assist with a header ... Sophomore GK **Michael Manahan** earned the shutout victory, making nine saves (three in OT) ... Grove City did not allow a goal against the Bison in two regular-season matches ... The teams tied 0-0 in Grove City's PAC opener Sept. 7 ... The Wolverines' six-match unbeaten streak came to an end Wednesday night with a 2-0 loss at Carnegie Mellon ... Grove City controls its own destiny in terms of hosting the PAC Tournament.



## Thomas More Saints

Thomas More will be back in action for the first time in 10 days when they face Westminster at Town and Country Soccer Complex ... The Saints remain in contention for the final PAC tournament spot ... Freshman **Kyle Morris** has scored three of his four goals in conference play.



## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets dropped their lone contest of the week on Wednesday, when they lost 5-1 to Westminster ... The Titans wasted little time in posting a lead, as **Blake Ordell** scored the first of his three goals just 34 seconds into the game ... Sophomore F **Michael Wilson**, however, trimmed the lead to 2-1 in the 16th minute off an assist from **George Silvestros** ... The goal by the Ohio native was his first since late September and team-leading ninth of the season ... The game remained 2-1 until the Titans added another goal at almost the 53-minute mark before Ordell put the game out of reach in the 58th minute when he recorded his hat trick ... Junior **Ross Philips** led the Yellow Jackets with three shots, followed by two from both senior **Luke Benton** and Wilson.
