Bethany Bison

Bethany played two matches against PAC rival W&J last week ... Both teams won at home, with the Presidents winning 2-1 Wednesday and the Bison winning in overtime, 1-0, Saturday ... Freshman **Tim Fratto** scored a goal with 1:42 left in overtime to give the Bison the win at home ... The defenses dominated the game, as the teams combined for just 16 total shots in over 98 minutes of action ... **Paulo Dos Santos** made six saves to post the shutout ... Earlier in the week, W&J defeated Bethany, 2-1 ... The Bison goal came from **Lavel Williams** in the 89th minute ... The team's next home game, Saturday vs. Westminster, will be Senior Day honoring defenders **Nick Krayvo** and **John Dwyer**.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J men's soccer had its unbeaten streak snapped at six matches on Saturday after falling at Bethany, 1-0, in overtime ... Senior GK **Mike Garet** took the loss despite making five saves ... Senior F **Mike Chiodo** gave the Presidents a 1-0 lead in the 32nd minute after converting a penalty kick Wednesday ... W&J freshman MF **Brian Beard** was brought down in the box in order for the penalty kick to be awarded ... The Presidents extended the lead to 2-0 in the 55th minute when sophomore MF **Brian Witkovitz** broke free for a goal off an assist from Beard ... Garet totaled six saves in the shutout for W&J, which was out-shot by a 13-6 margin despite picking up the win.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City had its six-match unbeaten streak come to an end against CMU Wednesday but the Wolverines rebounded for a 2-0 over Thiel Saturday ... **Bob McNees** had a goal and an assist against Thiel while **Nate Jones** scored the game-winner Saturday ... The Wolverines have posted nine shutouts this season, their highest total since tallying 10 in 2001 ... The victory also gave Grove City its eighth 10-win season in the last 10 years ... **Adam Ludwig** scored on a penalty kick in the Wolverines' 3-2 loss to CMU Wednesday ... It is Ludwig's third career penalty kick goal ... **Stuart McCommas** added his second goal of the season but the Wolverines could not complete the comeback.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College men's soccer team remained winless in conference play when it was shutout by Westminster College, 5-0, on Wednesday ... The Yellow Jackets have not registered a goal in their last 274 minutes, covering a span of four games ... The Jacket offense was outshot 19-8 as three different Jackets accounted for two shots each ... Waynesburg's last win came against Pitt-Bradford on September 18 and has not recorded a win in conference play since Oct. 25, 2003.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats played twice last week, losing at home to Penn State Behrend 2-1 Tuesday and at Grove City 2-0 Saturday ... Freshman **Nikola Vasilev** tallied his team-best 10th goal of the season to tie the PS-B game at 1-1 in the 38th minute, but the Lions managed to tally another score in the 60th minute to post the non-conference win ... Vasilev now holds both the school single-season goal scoring mark with 10 and point total with 22.

Westminster Titans

Westminster won its third straight game by blanking PAC foe Waynesburg 5-0 ... Freshman F **Andy Saporito** posted an unassisted goal for a 1-0 Titan lead ... Senior MF **Sebastian Driver-Salazar** gave Westminster a 2-0 advantage heading into halftime, as he scored in the 35th minute off an assist by freshman **Cory Criss** ... The Titans then added three insurance goals in the second half, starting with a tally by senior D **Zach Saxman** assisted by freshman **Cory Burns** in the opening minute after halftime ... The final goals came from frosh **Matt Kuza** assisted by Saporito and sophomore **Tarik Bakir** assisted by classmate **Sam Robinson** ... Freshman GK **Chris Passione** earned the shutout win, making eight saves.
