Kuuskowski posted six wins last week, three in each dual meet, as the Cougars went 2-0 with wins over PAC rival Bethany (153-123) and Notre Dame, Ohio (117-87). She captured the 100 freestyle (56.39) and swam on two victorious relays in the Bethany win, then claimed first in the 50 (25.76) and 500 freestyle (5:37.27) along with a relay against Notre Dame.

Also nominated was junior **Brenda Maxwell** of Bethany, freshman **Sarah Bargery** of Grove City, senior **Kaitlyn Orstein** of W&J, and junior **Megan Mier** of Westminster.

PAC SWIMMING & DIVING NOTES

Bethany Bison



Bethany closed out its dual meet schedule last week ... **Brenda Maxwell** was the top performer in the pool against Chatham, winning the 1650 freestyle (20:12.35) and the 200 IM (2:33.43) ... Also scoring first places in the water were **Erin Staniech** in the 50 freestyle (27.44) and **Jillian Zewe** in the 500 freestyle (6:08.53) ... In diving, **Desiree Finley** took first place in both competitions, which included scoring a season-high 190.35 in the one-meter event, and **Sara Patnesky** finished second on both boards ... The meet against Mount Union was highlighted by Maxwell winning three events: the 100 breaststroke, 500 freestyle and 400 IM ... The other first place was pulled in by Zewe in the 100 Fly ... For the men, **Kenny Drombosky** won the 50 freestyle with a season-best time of 22.56.

Chatham Cougars



Chatham finished the 2007-08 dual meet season with wins over Bethany College and the College of Notre Dame (OH) ... In a 148-121 win over Bethany, Chatham established two new school records ... **Kat Noble** set a new mark in the 1650 with a time of 21:22.22 ... The 200 free relay team of **Amy Kuuskoski, Chelsea Mummer, Courtney Crass** and **Carly Hicks** also established a new school mark with a time of 1:44.09 ... Chatham had to come from behind to beat the College of Notre Dame 117-87 on Saturday ... Chatham's A relay disqualified in the 200 IM to start the meet and Chatham found itself down 26-9 after two events ... However, the Cougars took first place in seven of the following nine events to secure the win.

Grove City Wolverines



Grove City concluded the regular season this weekend with three non-conference meets ... Friday night, both the men's and women's teams swept a double dual with Penn State Behrend and Pitt-Bradford ... Saturday, the men topped Wooster while the women fell to the Fighting Scots ... **Rich Albertson** picked up three wins Friday night for the men's team, winning both backstrokes and the 200 IM ... **Joe Riddell** won both diving events ... Saturday, Riddell won on the 1-meter board against Wooster ... **Peter Larsen** won the 100 free and 200 IM Saturday ... The men's team has 26 wins over the final two seasons, the most in any two-year span in program history ... The women's team swept Behrend and Pitt-Bradford Friday night ... **Whitney Fairchild** won the 1650 and 200 backstroke while **Sarah Bargery** won the breaststroke races ... **Sarah Page** won the 100 free and 200 fly ... Saturday, Page won the 50 while Bargery took the 200 breaststroke ... **Rebecca Smiddy** won the 1000 ... Grove City will host the PAC Championships in conjunction with the Grove City Invitational Feb. 14-16.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



Both Bearcat swim teams went 0-2 on the week ... In the women's 88-59 loss at W&J on Wednesday, the top SVC performance belonged to the 200 freestyle relay squad of

Olivia Cinberg, Amanda Haile, Molly Michael, and Sarah Denning, which finished in second place (1:50.20) ... Cinberg also took third in the 200 butterfly, while Haile finished third in the 1000 freestyle ... In the Lady Bearcats' 148-78 loss to Westminster Saturday, Cinberg took first in the 200 butterfly (2:24.94), while Haile won the 50 freestyle in 26.71 ... The Bearcat men had four winners in the team's 111-82 loss at W&J Wednesday, including **Jon Okonak** in the 50 freestyle (22.97), **Eric Clouse** in the 200 butterfly (2:15.24), **Joe Bruzda** in the 200 backstroke (2:07.07), and **Zack Krejdovsky** in the 500 freestyle (5:08.75) ... In Saturday's 151-92 defeat to Westminster, Okonak finished first in the 50 freestyle with a time of 22.95, while Clouse captured the 100 butterfly, finishing in 55.41 seconds.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents



W&J swept a pair of dual meets last week, with the women tying a school record with their 13th dual meet win of the year ... W&J also finished with an eight-meet win streak to end the dual season ...

The 2004-05 Presidents also notched 13 victories ... The W&J men also finished the year with a three-meet win streak ... Against SVC, five-time NCAA Division III National Champion senior **Kaitlyn Orstein** paced the women with wins in the 50 freestyle (24.57) and 200 breaststroke (2:34.19) ... Freshman **Brandon Smith** led the men's squad with three victories ... He won the 100 freestyle (50.27) and 200 IM (2:02.55), while also leading the 200 freestyle relay (1:32.11) to a victory ... Orstein helped the 200 medley relay (1:54.98) earn an opening victory against Hiram and then touched first in the 200 freestyle (1:56.83) and the 100 butterfly (58.76) ... Her time of 58.76 tied her own school record set earlier this season ... Smith claimed three first-place showings ... Senior **Brent Johnson** swam a leg on the winning relay during his final home meet as a President ... Junior **Brittany Bertoli** was also a part of three victories for the women.

Westminster Titans



Westminster posted a pair of wins at Saint Vincent Saturday ... The Titan men (8-2), ranked No. 25 in the country, won 151-92 and the Titan women (7-4) won 148-78, as each Westminster team finished first in 12 events ... Freshman **Aaron Whisman** contributed on four events wins (two individual), including first-place times in the 100 backstroke (55.88) and 500 freestyle (5:08.10), while swimming legs of the winning 200 medley and 200 freestyle relay teams ... Sophomore **Ben Gutmann** was the other Titan male swimming to win two individual events by touching first in the 100 breaststroke (1:00.16) and the 400 IM (4:29.54) ... On the women's side, junior **Megan Mier** helped win three events as she captured the 100 backstroke (1:03.40) and the 100 butterfly (1:02.46), while also swimming a leg on the 200 freestyle relay team ... Senior **Ashley Linnelli** won the 200 freestyle (2:04.29) and the 400 IM (4:57.03) making two Titan women who won multiple individual events.
