Hoelscher led the Saints to a 3-1 week, including a three-set sweep at Thiel in Thomas More's PAC opener, by averaging 4.93 kills per game. For the week, she posted 69 kills with 14 errors on 135 attempts for a .407 attack percentage, while adding 17 total blocks. In the Thiel win, Hoelscher had 16 kills and a .519 attack percentage.

Also nominated was senior OH **Linzy Turner** of Bethany, junior OH **Heather Fraiz** of Grove City, freshman S **Kristen Martin** of Thiel, senior OH **Taryn Terchanik** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior MH **Katie McDermott** of Westminster.

The Bison dropped their PAC opener in their lonely action of last week ... Westminster claimed the first two games from Bethany and appeared to be in control of the third with a 22-12 lead ... BC would battle back into the game by taking nine straight points to get within 22-21 ... The Titans would put the match away by winning eight of the final 10 points to finish the sweep ... Senior **Linzy Turner** notched five kills and 11 digs in the defeat ... This will be a busy week for the Bison, as they play three PAC matches ... After traveling to Grove City Tuesday and hosting Thiel Wednesday, Bethany goes to Thomas More Saturday to take on the Saints and Transylvania in a tri-match.

Grove City Wolverines



At 7-3, Grove City is off to its best start in eight years ... Grove City opened PAC play Wednesday with a sweep of Waynesburg ... Sophomore **Natalie Liberati** posted 12 kills in the win while junior **Heather Fraiz** added 11 kills ... Sophomore **Meghan Glenn** served three aces ... Fraiz tallied a team-best 11 kills in sweeps of Lake Erie and Pitt-Greensburg Friday night at the Westminster Invitational ... Grove City ultimately claimed third place by sweeping Pitt-Bradford Saturday ... The Wolverines fell into the third place match after closing pool play with a 3-0 loss to Penn State-Behrend ... **Katie Skinner** led the Wolverines with eight kills against Behrend ... Fraiz and senior **Allison Cummings** were each named to the All-Tournament team ... Grove City hosts Bethany in PAC action Tuesday night.



Thiel Tomcats

The Thomas More College volleyball team earned a 3-0 Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) victory over Thiel College Sunday afternoon at Beeghly Gymnasium ... The Saints (7-6, 1-0 PAC) picked up wins of 30-27, 30-24, and 30-24 and handed the Tomcats (6-3, 0-1 PAC) a loss in the PAC opener for both squads ... Freshman OH **LaToya Locke** posted 11 kills and three blocks in the loss for the Tomcats ... Freshman MH **Liz Sitko** 10 kills, seven blocks and four digs. Freshman S **Kristen Martin** added 32 assists, nine digs and four blocks, while freshman DS **Heather Peck** added 12 digs.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More bookended its week with straight game victories, going 3-1 overall ... The Saints also picked up their first PAC win of the season, downing the Thiel Tomcats, 30-27, 30-24, 30-24 ... Freshman **Leslie Hoelscher** hit .519 in the win over Thiel with 16 kills on 27 attempts and two errors ... For the week, she recorded 69 kills on 135 attempts and just 14 errors (.407 hitting %) ... Through 13 matches, Hoelscher has recorded 31 block solos, leaving her 13 shy of the Thomas More single season record ... Sophomore **Jessica Tyner** added 12 kills with no errors in the Thiel win ... Freshman **Kristine Rust** had 62 kills for the week ... With 128 assists this past weekend in just three games, junior **Valeri Kuhn** needs just 136 assists to break the school record.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J dropped two out of three matches last week ... The Presidents' lone win came against Ohio Dominican as senior OH **Taryn Terchanik** racked up 21 kills and eight blocks ... Junior OH **Gabby Zagari** notched 11 kills, 10 digs and four blocks, while junior **Beth Mihalik** added 11 kills, four digs, three blocks and two aces ... Freshman LIB **Nellica Davis** accumulated 24 digs and four aces ... In the loss to Wittenberg, senior OH **Stacie Ley** notched a double-double with 17 kills and 15 digs, while Zagari (13), Mihalik (11) and Terchanik (10) all accumulated double-digit kill totals ... Senior S **Jamie Gullen** finished with 58 assists ... Ley accumulated 10 kills and 27 digs in the 3-1 setback at Saint Vincent ... Mihalik added 15 kills and four blocks, while Zagari had 12 kills and seven digs.

Against Muskingum, **Mary Beth Crouch** and **Kaci Hlad** led the Yellow Jackets with seven kills, while **Ashley Kreinbrook** paced Waynesburg with 19 digs and Hlad added 10 digs ... The Yellow Jackets dropped their conference opener on Wednesday when they lost to Grove City, 3-0 ... **Laurie Lindner** registered her eighth double-double of the season, as she posted 15 kills and 11 digs ... Hlad also posted a double-double with 10 kills and 10 digs ... S **Amanda Staudt** recorded 41 assists in the loss and MH **Amanda Jo Morgan** added eight kills and four blocks in the conference opener.

Westminster Titans



Westminster went 4-1 during the week and saw its 11-match win streak end in the championship of the Volley Against Violence Invitational ... The Titans won 13 straight games during the week, including the first of its finals match vs. PS-Behrend, before losing the match, 3-1 ... Senior MH **Katie McDermott** and sophomore S **Traci Hassell** were named to the all-tournament team ...
