PAC VOLLEYBALL 2008 - Week 9 Conference Notes

TITANS CLINCH TOP SEED: The battle for the top seed and hosting rights for the 2008 PAC volleyball season is over, as Westminster clinched the top spot following two PAC wins last week and league losses by Thomas More and W&J ... The six tournament teams are set, with Thiel, Grove City and Waynesburg joining the top three schools ... Saint Vincent continued its red-hot play with a 4-0 mark last week, including a five-set win over Westminster, as the Bearcats prepare to defend their ECAC championship.

WHO'S HOT: Geneva eclipsed the 20-win plateau for the first time in three seasons with a three set sweep of Waynesburg last week ... Thomas More freshman OH/MB **Hillary Monnin** posted 37 kills and 57 digs in four matches for the 3-1 Saints last week ... Westminster freshman MB **Lindsay Speidel** recorded 2.54 kills per game for the 3-1 Titans, including 15 in a four-set win over W&J ... Junior OH **Abbey Kiger** had 29 kills and 11 digs for 1-1 Thiel ... Senior **Laurie Lindner** had 49 kills for 1-2 Waynesburg.

NEWS & NOTES: With wins over W&J and Thomas More last week, Grove City head coach **Susan Roberts** now has 687 career wins in all sports (520-VB, 101-WBB, 66-SB) at the College, tying **Jim Longnecker** for first all-time at GCC ... Sophomore OH **Courtney Holdrieth** had 23 kills and 29 digs for 0-2 W&J last week ... Freshman S **Megan Hoffman** passed out 85 assists in three matches for 0-3 Bethany last week, including a career-high tying 45 assists at Waynesburg ... Chatham went 0-4 last week.

Bethany Bison
(5-22, 2-10 PAC)



Bethany was eliminated from PAC Tournament contention last week ... Freshman S **Megan Hoffman** had a nice week, passing out 85 assists, including a career-high tying 45 in the Waynesburg match-up ... Hoffman also reached double digit digs with 14 against Thomas More ... Twin sister **Tiffany Hoffman** registered 55 digs in the three matches, with a high of 23 at Waynesburg ... The Waynesburg match saw a lot of good numbers posted by Bison hitters, as **Courtney Meadows** hammered 17 kills and **Sumer Scott** and **Alyssa Schreengost** each had 10 ... The 10 kills tied a season-best for Scott, while Schreengost added four aces in the loss.

Chatham Cougars
(0-23, 0-13 PAC)



Chatham went 0-4 on the week, dropping its overall record to 0-23 and PAC record to 0-13 ... Chatham did get help this week as setter **Olivia Hess** returned from injury that kept her out of competition for four weeks ... The Cougars are looking for their first win of the season when they host Waynesburg on Tuesday, October 28 ... Earlier this season, Chatham lost to the Yellow Jackets 3-1.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes
(21-9)



Geneva's volleyball team had mixed results in four PAC matches last week with a pair of victories and a pair of losses ... The week started out promising with shut-out victories over Waynesburg and Thiel ... Over the weekend, the Golden Tornadoes dropped matches to Westminster and Thomas More ... Thomas More became the first PAC school to defeat Geneva twice this season ... The Golden Tornadoes did eclipse the 20-win plateau for the first time in three years ... The Golden Tornadoes will celebrate senior night this Tuesday to honor the trio of **Faith Guerra**, **Blair Bruce** and **Elizabeth Fisher**, each of whom have started for the Golden Tornadoes in each of the last four years.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City continued its late-season surge by toppling a pair of the conference' upper-echelon squads last week ... Thursday night, the Wolverines rallied from a 2-0 hole to down host W&J ... **Natalie Liberati** led Grove City with 11 kills while **Anna McCurdy** collected 10 kills ... It is Grove City's third straight win at W&J ... Saturday, the Wolverines rolled past visiting Thomas More, 3-1 ... Liberati posted 14 kills, 10 digs and three blocks in the win while **Inge Rasmussen** added 11 kills and 16 digs ... McCurdy tallied 20 digs ... **Annie Barry** recorded 42 assists and three aces ... Grove City clinches the No. 5 seed in the PAC Tournament with two wins this week.

Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats extended their win streak to seven after posting a 4-0 week ... In Tuesday's 3-1 home win over Bethany, **Christa Calgaro** posted 16 digs, while **Diana Petrovich** had 13 kills and **Anna Wasik** 12 kills and six blocks ... Four different players had two aces for SVC, including Petrovich, Calgaro, **Kelsie Bumbarger**, and **Briana Butterworth** ... On Wednesday, SVC picked up a five-set win at Waynesburg ... Wasik had a career-high 16 kills, while Petrovich added 13 ... Calgaro posted 20 digs and Bumbarger 19, to go with 51 assists ... SVC closed the week out by defeating Chatham (3-0) and Westminster (3-2) Saturday ... Petrovich tallied 33 kills, while **Taylor Guido** had 24 kills and 33 digs.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel split a pair of matches last week, while upping its conference record to 8-4 on the season ... In Thiel's only PAC match of the week, the Tomcats breezed by the Chatham Cougars, 3-0 ... Junior **Abbey Kiger** and freshman **Sarah Weikart** teamed up to spark the Tomcat offense by firing 12 and seven kills, respectively ... Thiel fell in three games to Geneva, to fall to 13-14 on the year ... Kiger had 17 kills with **Madison Chylik** setting up 26 assists ... Entering the season's final week, coach **Steve Brewer's** squad still has a chance to become the first Thiel women's team to finish with a .500 or better record in six years.

Thomas More Saints

Freshman DS **Emily Bohman** had 70 digs last week to lead the Saints' defense ... Through the Saints' 30 matches, freshman MB **Katie Sullivan** leads the team in hitting with a .325 percentage with 204 kills and has a team-high 57 blocks ... Sophomore OH **Lindsay Svec** leads the team in kills with 245, while **Bohman** leads the team with 489 digs and freshman setter **Michelle Clifford** has 1,118 assists.
