Dolsak led the Titans to a pair of wins against conference opponents last week, as she averaged 16.5 points and 9.0 rebounds per game while shooting 52 percent (12-of-23) from the field. She posted her second career double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds in a 56-54 overtime win over Thiel Wednesday, then recorded 16 points and eight caroms for Westminster in a 76-61 decision over Geneva Saturday.

Also nominated was sophomore F **Katelynn Hackathorn** of Bethany, junior G/F **Kayla Hilko** of Chatham, junior F **Christine Slater** of Grove City, freshman F **Kelly Barzak** of Thiel, junior C **Nicole Dickman** of Thomas More, senior PG **Kennan Killeen** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman F **Brittany Spencer** of Waynesburg.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 9 Conference Notes

TMC, W&J REMAIN ON TOP: Nationally-ranked PAC members Thomas More and Washington & Jefferson remain tied in the loss column as the PAC women's basketball race nears the halfway point ... The defending PAC champion Saints suffered their lone loss at W&J on January 7, while the Presidents suffered a home loss to Grove City on Dec. 5 ... TMC and W&J meet again in Crestview Hills, Ky., on Feb. 6 ... The 13-2 Saints host 12-3 Saint Vincent at home this Wednesday.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More and W&J are ranked 17th and 25th, respectively, in last week's WBCA poll ... Saint Vincent has won four straight games entering Wednesday's matchup at TMC, with sophomore **Emily Fenton** averaging 14.0 ppg in a pair of wins last week ... Both the W&J men's and women's teams were ranked fourth in the nation in NCAA D-III in free throw percentage last week ... Junior F **Christine Slater** averaged 13.5 ppg and 10.5 rpg last week for 1-1 Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Freshman F **Kelly Barzak** averaged 18.5 ppg for 0-2 Thiel ... Junior G/F **Kayla Hilko** averaged 16.5 ppg for 1-1 Chatham ... Freshman **Kayla Taormina** averaged 14.0 ppg in a pair of losses for Bethany, including 17 in a near-upset of Thomas More ... Freshman F **Brittany Spencer** averaged 9.5 ppg and 8.0 rpg for 0-2 Waynesburg ... Westminster senior G **Amy Dolsak** posted a career-high 25 points in a win over Geneva ... Geneva's **Christine Carugati** scored 15 in the WC loss.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (4-11, 1-5 PAC)



The Bison fell to 1-7 this season in games decided by seven points or less with two more close losses last week ... Bethany took #17 Thomas More to overtime and was still tied with 1:14 to go before the Saints scored the final seven points to claim a 78-71 win ... **Katelynn Hackathorn** set career-highs with 18 points and 13 rebounds and **Kayla Toarmina** totaled 17 markers and nine boards in the defeat ... The Bison suffered through a seven-minute stretch without a point against Chatham, who scored 10 straight to take control and go on to a 57-51 win over BC ... Although they held a 38-22 rebounding advantage, Bethany shot just 36 percent (19-of-53) ... **Audra Droginske** dropped in 13 and Toarmina totaled 11.

Chatham Cougars (7-7, 2-4 PAC)



The Cougars took on 2008-09 PAC runner-up Washington and Jefferson this week at home before hitting the road to take on the Bison of Bethany College ... Chatham fell to W&J in the closing seconds, as W&J senior PG **Kennan Killeen** banked in a three-pointer from the top of the arc for a 53-50 win ... **Kayla Hilko** led the Cougars with a team-high 14 points and seven rebounds in the loss while **Barb Petty** chipped in with 11 points and five boards ... In the PAC match-up against Bethany, Chatham came out on top, earning the victory with a final score of 57-51 ... This victory marked the first time the Cougars have defeated the Bison in program history ... Hilko again led Chatham with a game-, and season-high 19 points.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (5-10)



Geneva reached a season-low five-game losing streak after a pair of losses to Grove City and Westminster last week ... The week began with Geneva's second consecutive overtime loss after suffering a similar fate against Chatham two weeks ago ... The Golden Tornadoes rallied to score the final ten points of regulation to force the extra session against the Wolverines ... Saturday, Geneva never got on track and never led in a 76-61 loss to Westminster ... The lone bright spot came from the performance of junior **Christine Carugati**, who posted a team-high 15 points in the loss ... The Golden Tornadoes are still winless on the road with a mark of 0-8.

Grove City Wolverines (7-8, 3-2 PAC)



Grove City has alternated wins and losses over the past two weeks ... The Wolverines went 1-1 last week, including a 60-51 overtime win at home against Geneva ... GCC has now played a school-record four overtime games this year ... **Megan Gebrosky** scored six of her 16 points in the extra period ... **Christine Slater** had 17 points and 13 rebounds ... **Laura Miller** went 5-for-6 at the foul line in overtime as part of a 13-point outing ... The Wolverines have now won four straight against Geneva ... Saturday night, the Wolverines had 29 turnovers in a setback at Saint Vincent ... **Leah Gibson** fired in 14 points for the Wolverines while Slater finished with 10 points and eight rebounds.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-3)



The Bearcats improved to 12-3 with wins over Waynesburg and Grove City on the week ... In the Waynesburg contest, **Emily Fenton** came off the bench to lead the way with 18 points, eight rebounds, and eight assists, while **Melissa Mansur** added 15 and **Brittany Sedlock** 15 points and 11 rebounds ... SVC connected on a season-high 10 three-pointers, while forcing 22 Waynesburg turnovers ... In the Grove City contest, three players scored in double-figures, led by **Maria Baroffio's** 17 points ... **Devin McGrath** pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds with three steals, while Fenton scored 10 points with four assists.

Thiel Tomcats (4-10, 1-6 PAC)



In their second overtime in as many games, the women of Thiel College basketball came up short against the Westminster Titans, losing 56-54 on Wednesday despite a record-breaking defensive effort from **Kelly Barzak** ... Barzak tallied a Thiel College single-game record nine blocks to go along with 15 points and six rebounds ... Thiel fell at the hands of the Thomas More Saints 74-50 on Saturday.

Thomas More Saints (13-2, 6-1 PAC)



The 17th-ranked Saints went 2-0 last week as it defeated Bethany, 78-71, in overtime on the road and then returned to Kentucky to defeat Thiel, 74-50 ... In the win over Thiel, all 12 Saints in uniform scored at least two points in the game ... Junior C **Nicole Dickman** led the team in scoring and rebounding last week as she averaged 17.5 points per game and 7.5 rebounds per game ... Freshman G **Chelsea Tolliver** was second in both categories with 16.0 ppg., and 5.5 rpg. ... Tolliver and Dickman are the only two Saints averaging in double-figures as they averaged 14.5 ppg., and 12.1 ppg., respectively ... As a team the Saints are shooting 45.1 percent from the field on 395-of-875 shooting.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (13-2, 5-1 PAC)



W&J, ranked 25th in the WBCA USA Today/ESPN Top 25, extended its season-best win streak to six after collecting a pair of PAC victories last week ... The Presidents opened the week with a dramatic 53-50 triumph at Chatham Wednesday and handled Waynesburg 65-49 on Saturday ... Senior PG **Kennan Killeen** banked in a three-pointer as the game clock expired to lift the Presidents to the three-point victory against the Cougars ... Junior F **Jamie McKittrick** fired in a career-high 15 points and senior F **Maggie Gibson** collected her seventh double-double of the season (11 points, 10 rebounds) in Saturday's triumph over the Yellow Jackets.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (5-10, 2-5 PAC)



It was a rough week for the Waynesburg women's hoops team as they faced off with two of the top teams in the conference in a pair of home contests ... The Yellow Jackets were swept on the week by Saint Vincent and Washington & Jefferson, ending a three-game stretch against opponents from the PAC with 12 or more victories ... Though the Jackets weren't able to pick up a victory, they did enjoy some solid individual performances ... Junior F **Elisha Jones** averaged a team-high 13.5 points per game, and poured in a game-high 18 points against the Presidents ... Freshman F **Brittany Spencer** averaged 9.5 points and eight rebounds per contest.

Westminster Titans (6-9, 4-2 PAC)



Westminster went 2-1 last week, winning a pair of home games vs. PAC teams before losing at Penn State-Beaver, 71-66, Monday ... The Titans started the week by beating Thiel, 56-54, in overtime before routing Geneva, 76-61, on Saturday ... Sophomore F **Emily Dolsak**, who hadn't score in double figures for eight straight games leading up to this week, led the Titans with 15.7 points per game including a season-high 17 vs. Thiel, 16 vs. Geneva, and 14 vs. Penn State-Beaver ... Dolsak averaged 7.7 rebounds, including 10 vs. Thiel for her second career double-double ... Senior G **Amy Dolsak** was the other Titan to average double figures with 15.0 points per game and a team-best 8.3 rpg.
