PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BRITTANY BROWN **Chatham University**

5-11 sophomore forward

Brown averaged a double double with 17.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game for the 1-1 Cougars last week, as Chatham dropped a 71-69 overtime decision to Saint Vincent before recording a come-from-behind 74-71 victory over Thiel. In the victory over the Tomcats, she posted 21 points (on 5-of-6 shooting from the field and 10-of-12 accuracy from the line), including eight markers in the final three minutes.

Also nominated was junior G **Kaitlyn McCormick** of Bethany, senior F **Tandrea Sellers** of Thomas More, sophomore F **Maggie Gibson** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior G/F **Emilee Ackerman** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES



Bethany Bison

Bethany improved to 6-3 in the PAC with a 77-50 rout of Waynesburg Wednesday ... The Bison closed the game with an 18-0 run over the final eight minutes ... **Kelly Goode** dropped in 21 points and was joined in double digits by **Kaitlyn McCormick** (16), **Susannah Cartland** (15) and **Stacy Goode** (13), who recorded a double-double with 10 steals, the second-most in a single game in Bethany history ... Against Geneva, the Bison fell victim to a big second half run, as the Golden Tornadoes used a 25-4 spurt to pull away for a 75-58 win ... **Tara Harris** came off the bench to score a career-high 18 points and also pull down nine boards.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva managed a pair of victories over PAC opponents last week on the heroics of senior F Allyson Clarke ... Clarke posted her 14th and 15th double-doubles of the season and averaged 28.5 pts and 12.5 rebounds in the two victories ... Geneva watched W&J rally from 11 points down at halftime to tie the game 44-44 ... Down the stretch, Geneva got great contributions from **Renee Rawding**, who scored 15 of her 17 points in the second half ... Saturday, Geneva turned a close game in a rout late with a 21-7 second half run to put the game away ... **Michawn Rich** posted season highs with 19 points and 14 rebounds in the victory over Bethany.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats won a pair of PAC road contests last week, defeating Chatham in overtime Wednesday and then holding off Waynesburg Saturday ... At Chatham, **Ashley Campbell** hit a buzzer beater at the end of regulation to send it into overtime, and then hit two free throws with 20 seconds left in OT to clinch the 71-69 win ... **Janelle Reed** and **Laura Klimchok** each scored 19 points, while **Caryn Glassbrenner** recorded the double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds ... In SVC's 61-55 win at Waynesburg, five Bearcats scored in double figures in the win, led by Reed's 13 points and **Maria Baroffio's** 12.



Thomas More Saints

Senior **Tandrea Sellers** and junior **Jayme Thiem** each averaged 17.5 points per game this week as Thomas More won over PAC foes ... Thiel and Westminster by an average of 21 points per game ... The duo combined for 44 points in Thomas More's win over Thiel ... Freshman **Nicole Dickman** added 11.0 points and a team-high 8.5 rebounds ... Sellers led four players in double figures with 15 points in the Saints' comeback victory over Westminster.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Despite a pair of tightly contested games, the Yellow Jackets suffered losses to Bethany, 77-50, and Saint Vincent, 61-55 ... Against the Bison, Waynesburg trailed by just nine points with 8:20 left before Bethany finished the game on an 18-0 run ... Freshman F **Elisha Jones** scored a team-high 14 points with nine rebounds and three blocks, while junior F **Michaelene Jones** collected a game-high 11 rebounds ... Saturday, the Yellow Jackets trailed by one in the final minute before the Bearcats sealed the win with free throws. Junior F **Jeanette Wonsetteler** led the team with 15 points, while freshman G **Marquis Demniak** scored 12 points.



Chatham Cougars

Chatham split two home games last week ... First-year **Lizz King** scored a career-high 21 points in a 71-69 overtime loss to Saint Vincent College on Wednesday ... Chatham held a two-point lead in the closing seconds of regulation, but the Bearcats got a buzzer-beater tip-in to send the game to overtime ... Sophomore **Brittany Brown** added a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds ... Brown had her second double-double of the week when she scored 21 points and grabbed 10 boards in a 74-71 win over Thiel ... First-years **Barb Petty** and **Kayla Hilko** each had career-highs in scoring with 21 and 16 points, respectively.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's five-game win streak came to a halt Saturday against visiting Washington & Jefferson ... GCC shot 21 percent (14 of 66) from the field against the Presidents ... **Krista Beechy** led the Wolverines with 11 points and nine rebounds ... Wednesday, Grove City used an 18-0 first-half run to take control of a 61-51 win at Westminster ... **Christine Slater** led GCC with 19 points ... Nine different Wolverines scored in the win ... Grove City shot 6-of-10 behind the three-point line in the first half ... The Wolverines snapped a three-game slide against Westminster ... Grove City is 6-0 this year when scoring at least 61 points in a game this year.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped a pair of PAC contests last week, falling at home to Thomas More 87-58 Wednesday before suffering a 74-71 loss at Chatham on Saturday ... Junior G **Amber Bodrick** and junior G **Catie Sieber** each finished with 14 points in the loss to TMC ... Bodrick added nine rebounds and five assists ... Thiel led 34-25 at the half against Chatham, but faltered in the second as they were outscored 49-37 ... Despite the loss, Bodrick moved into second place on the school's all-time scoring list ... Her 19-point, 13-rebound effort gave her 1,393 career points, passing **Julie Sierota** '90 (1,388) for the number two spot behind all-time leader **Tricia Kosenina** '93 (2,086).



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J ended Grove City's five-game win streak on Saturday by posting a 33-point win ... The Presidents jumped out to an early 11-0 lead and never looked back, building a 20-point halftime advantage ... Sophomore F **Maggie Gibson** made all five of her shots from the floor and finished with 15 points and 10 rebounds ... 13 different Presidents scored during the win ... W&J limited the Wolverines to 21 percent shooting ... Geneva was able to hold off a late W&J rally Wednesday ... Sophomore PG **Kennan Killeen** was the only President in double figures with 16 points, while Gibson pulled down 14 rebounds.



Westminster Titans

Westminster is in the midst of a season-long, five-game losing streak after suffering PAC home losses to Grove City, 61-51, Wednesday and vs. fifth-ranked and unbeaten Thomas More, 69-56, Saturday ... The Titans led the Saints midway through the second half ... Senior G/F **Emilee Ackerman** led all scorers and rebounders in the TMC game with 17 rebounds and 10 boards, while **Gina Brunetti** bucketed 14 and grabbed seven rebounds. Against Grove City, Ackerman scored a game-high 26 points and pulled down 11 rebounds as she moved into third place on the team's career scoring list (1,245 points through Saturday).

The Bison watched a 23-point second half lead get trimmed to three with a minute to play, but **Lisa Mitchell** hit four foul shots to secure an 80-75 win ... Bethany will try for the season sweep of Saint Vincent Saturday ... The Bison scored the third-most points in school history on Jan. 9 in a 99-88 triumph over the Bearcats.
