**PAC PLAY READY TO ROLL:** The PAC league schedule gets underway with 10 games this week - five on Wednesday and five on Saturday ... The PAC will likely have a pair of teams in the WBCA/USA Today National Top 25 poll this week ... W&J entered the poll last week at #25 and responded with a 14-point road win at Allegheny ... Defending PAC champion Thomas More, which was second among others receiving votes, swept the Julie Costello Classic, including a win over #12 DePauw.

**NEWS & NOTES:** Laura Miller of Grove City posted 10 points, eight rebounds and six assists in a win over previously unbeaten Carnegie Mellon ... Westminster senior G **Amy Dolsak** posted team-high totals of 20 points and eight rebounds in the Titans' 57-48 win over La Roche ... **Maria Baroffio** bucketed a team-high 16 points for Saint Vincent in a home victory over Ursuline ... Sophomore F **Renee Shepherd** had 17 points and eight boards for Bethany in a loss to Muskingum.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Senior F **Maggie Gibson** posted her 29th career double-double for W&J with a 10-point, 13-rebound effort in a win at Allegheny ... Thomas More freshman Gs **Allison Long** and **Chelsea Tolliver** both earned All-Tournament honors ... **Ashley Davis** averaged 13.6 ppg and 5.6 rpg for 1-2 Thiel ... **Beth DeLuca** led all Geneva scorers with 13 points in a loss at Fredonia State ... First-year F **Andre'a Thompson** averaged 11.0 ppg in a pair of losses for 0-2 Chatham.

## Bethany Bison (1-3, 0-0 PAC)



Bethany's lone action of the week saw them drop a 70-63 decision against Muskingum in their home opener ... The Bison trimmed a 12-point second half deficit to four with 2:20 to play, but the Muskies, who went 20-for-26 from the foul line in the game, held on for the win ... Bethany, who was just 6-for-10 from the charity stripe, had three players reach double figures in points, led by **Renee Shepherd** with a career-high 17 and eight rebounds ... **Katelynn Hackathorn** totaled 10 points and seven boards and **Carly Garneau** came off the bench to tally 10.

## Chatham Cougars (3-2, 0-0 PAC)



Chatham lost both games this weekend in their Thanksgiving tournament, first to visiting Denison and then to Kenyon ... Denison trailed the Cougars by 14 with less than 11 minutes to play and rallied to go on a 20-0 run in the next seven minutes to secure the victory ... **Kayla Hilko** scored a team-high 15 points and added six rebounds for Chatham in the loss ... In the nail-biter against Kenyon, the game was close for 40 minutes, but Chatham was unable to earn the victory ... Hilko led the Cougars with 19 points, eight from the foul line ... Hilko now has 602 career points, making her only the sixth Cougar in the 21-year school history to pass 600 total points ... **Lizz King** chipped in with 11 points.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (2-3)



The Golden Tornadoes suffered through a 0-2 week with losses to Penn State Beaver and Fredonia State along the way ... After winning two of its first three games, Geneva will try to turn around a two-game losing streak as it opens PAC play this week ... Last week, Geneva was bit by the turnover bug with 29 miscues in each loss ... Against Penn State-Beaver, Geneva got 11 points from **Val Hamilton** and 10 each from **Renee Rawding** and **Chelsea D'Urso**, but it was not enough in a 72-65 loss to the Lions ... Geneva watched a five-point halftime lead evaporate against Fredonia being outscored 45-23 in the final stanza ... **Beth DeLuca** led all Geneva scorers with 13 points.

## Grove City Wolverines (1-3, 0-0 PAC)



Grove City earned its first win of the season Tuesday night by administering a 77-59 beating to previously-unbeaten Carnegie Mellon ... Four GCC players scored in double figures, led by **Christine Slater's** 20-point outing ... **Krista Beechy** and **Leah Gibson** both had 11 points while **Laura Miller** added 10 points ... Miller also had eight rebounds and six assists ... Slater's nine boards helped Grove City own a 36-33 rebounding edge ... GCC shot 49 percent from the field in the win ... The Wolverine defense forced 26 turnovers and held CMU to 8-for-27 shooting in the first half ... Grove City had not won its home opener since 2004 ... The Wolverines are shooting 77 percent at the foul line this year.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (3-1)



The Bearcats were victorious in their only action on the week, downing NAIA foe Ursuline 74-46 on Tuesday evening ... Five players scored at least seven points for SVC, led by **Maria Baroffio's** 16 ... **Emily Fenton** added 11 and **Brittany Sedlock** 10, with Fenton picking up four steals and Sedlock going a perfect 4-for-4 from the field and 2-for-2 from the stripe ... **Kathy Bianco** turned in an eight-point, eight-rebound, five-assist performance at the point guard spot, while the Bearcat defense forced 32 turnovers and limited Ursuline to just 26 percent (14-of-52) accuracy from the field.

## Thiel Tomcats (2-3, 0-0 PAC)



In an evening marred by turnovers, Thiel fell 95-47 to Division II Edinboro ... Despite having four players reach double figures in scoring, Thiel dropped its third game of the season, 73-56, to the College of Mount Saint Joseph at the Marietta Turkey Shootout on Saturday ... With their strongest defensive performance of the season, the Tomcat women picked up their second win of the season on Sunday when they beat the Oberlin College Yeomen, 75-63 ... Sophomore **F Ashley Davis** scored a game-high 20 points and nine rebounds en route to an all-tournament nod.

## Thomas More Saints (4-0, 0-0 PAC)



Thomas More extended its season-opening win streak to four games as it defeated 12<sup>th</sup>-ranked DePauw and Oglethorpe last weekend at the Julie Costello Memorial Classic ... Junior C **Nicole Dickman** extended her streak of double-doubles to four games, as she had 19 points and 10 rebounds against DePauw and 12 points and 10 rebounds against Oglethorpe ... Two other Saints averaged double-figure scoring last week as freshmen Gs **Allison Long** and **Chelsea Tolliver** averaged 14 and 10 points, respectively ... Dickman was named MVP of the Costello Memorial Classic, while Tolliver and Long joined her on the All-Tournament team.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (4-0, 0-0 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson entered the WBCA/USA Today Top 25 rankings at #25 last Tuesday and extended its regular-season win streak to seven games following a 53-39 win at Allegheny ... W&J took control of the game with a 12-1 run to begin the second half ... Senior F **Maggie Gibson** posted 10 points and 13 rebounds in the win ... Gibson now owns 29 career double-doubles, including two this season ... Senior G Stephanie Smith was the only other President in double figures with 10 ... Gibson, Smith and PG **Kennan Killeen** have notched a 71-21 record during their careers at W&J, including a 33-7 record in the PAC ... Last year's senior class set the school record with 89 wins.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (0-2, 0-0 PAC)



The Yellow Jacket women have been off since Nov. 21, and should be well rested when they return to the courts on Monday, Nov. 30, for a road game at Penn State-Greater Allegheny ... Waynesburg will be looking for its first win of the season when they face the Lady Lions.

## Westminster Titans (1-3, 0-0 PAC)



Westminster picked up its first win of the season with a 57-48 victory over La Roche at home Saturday ... **Amy Dolsak** bucketed a season-high 20 points and eight rebounds ... **Emily Dolsak** scored 10 points to go with five rebounds ... **Kaitlin McCarthy** scored nine points while handing out a game-high four assists, all in the second half ... The Titans shot 41.7 percent (20-48) from the floor while limiting the Redhawks to 30.9 percent (21-68) ... La Roche held a stark turnover advantage, committing just nine to Westminster's 21 ... The Titans led by as many as 18 points in the second half before La Roche whittled the Titans' lead down to seven points at 53-46 with 2:04 remaining.

The last match-up saw BC rally from a 12-point halftime deficit to force OT and then claim a 68-63 victory in the PAC Quarterfinals.
