PAC TRADITIONS: A total of 14 schools and more than 300 wrestlers competed in the 4th-Annual Washington & Jefferson College Open Saturday at the Henry Memorial Center ... The unscored meet hosted a combination of Division I, II and III schools ... Waynesburg competed against the Red Raiders of Shippensburg and won the first four bouts of the evening and built up a 14-0 lead, before sealing the eventual 20-15 win.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Facing mostly Division I and II competition, Waynesburg's **Corbin Semple** placed a team-high fifth in the 184-lbs. category ... Thiel's **Todd Miller** went 2-3 in the 197 lbs. bracket, including a pin of his first opponent of the day – UPJ's Damian Majocho – in 6:42 ... W&J's 157-pounder **Dominick Demor** and freshman 141-pounder **Tyler Berger** were the only Presidents' place winners after both notched fifth.
