Bethany won its first game of the season in its 2004 home opener on Saturday against Lake Erie ... Bethany scored two goals in the game after doing so only once during the whole 2003 season ... Freshman led the way to victory, as **Rachelle Smith** scored the first goal of the game, then assisted on the game-winner ... Freshman goalie **Jessica Alloggia** came up with four saves, including stopping an open shot by a Lake Erie player with just over 10 minutes left in the game that would have tied the score ... The game-winning goal was scored by **Pennie Thomas**, after the ball hit off the hands of the Erie goalie and into the net.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson began the 2004 season with a pair of tough home losses ... 23rd-ranked Allegheny broke open a scoreless tie with 16 minutes remaining on a goal by **Jen Bilec** ... AC tacked on an insurance goal with under a minute to play ... Sophomore GK **Marguerite Egan** kept the Presidents alive all evening by making 11 saves ... The game was the first soccer match in history played at W&J's new Alexandre Stadium ... CMU's **Lisa Pascoli** scored just over three minutes into the second overtime period to lift the Tartans past W&J, 1-0, on Saturday ... Egan made nine saves in the loss for the Presidents, who were out-shot by a 21-3 margin ... Washington & Jefferson now plays four straight road contests.
