Senior GK **Ashleigh Dunsmore** posted six saves in the loss at Lake Erie ... PS-A opened the scoring in the first minute of play when **Nicole Grindle** scored ... The Lions followed that up in the 38th minute when **Jessica Singer** knocked in a corner kick ... Freshman **Christen Hernandez** cut the Lion lead to 2-1 in the 54th minute with her first career score, but Singer struck for her second goal to Altoona up 3-1...Dunsmore made 14 stops for the Tomcats in the loss ... Thiel will open PAC play Saturday when they travel to Waynesburg to face the Yellow Jackets (3 p.m.).
