Pergola scored four goals, including both game-winners, as the Presidents posted conference wins over Bethany (4-2) and Thiel (6-0) last week. She posted a hat trick to help W&J overcome a 2-1 deficit against the Bison. Pergola now has 58 career goals, which ranks second all-time at Washington & Jefferson.

## Bethany Bison

An injury-ravaged Bethany squad dropped three PAC games last week, including two on the road ... **Pennie Thomas** scored twice in the first half to give BC a 2-1 halftime lead against W&J, but the Presidents scored three times in the second half to claim the triumph ... **Katie Piacquadio** and **Rachelle Smith** recorded assists on the goals ... The Bison then dropped a 5-1 decision at Grove City after falling behind 3-0 in the first half ... BC played the game without captain **Jen Burin** and **Jill Wright** because of injuries ... In the final game of the week, Thomas More scored three times in the second half to pull away for a 4-0 win over the Bison Sunday ... GK **Jessica Alloggia** stopped 13 shots in the loss.



## Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat women's soccer team fell in three matches last week, losing at Westminster 6-0 on Monday, at Penn State Behrend Thursday and at home to W&J 6-0 on Saturday ... Senior GK **Ashleigh Dunsmore** totaled 40 saves in the three losses ... Dunsmore is currently fourth in Division III in saves per game, averaging 13.33 per contest.



## Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went undefeated in PAC play last week, going 2-0-1 in three matches ... Grove City opened the week with a 2-0 win over Waynesburg ... Freshman **Anne Koller** scored the game-winner, her first career goal ... Classmate **Sara Griffin** provided the assist, her first ... Junior **Maia Siber** scored an unassisted insurance goal ... Senior **Katie Klingensmith** contributed to all five goals in Grove City's 5-1 home win over Bethany Thursday ... Klingensmith scored twice and assisted on the other three goals ... Senior **Stacey Brubaker** scored twice while Siber also scored ... Brubaker, **Kristin Hummel** and **Katie Wolff** all had assists ... Freshman **Bethany Preston** posted two shutouts and allowed one goal in the three matches.



## Thomas More Saints

Thomas More ran its unbeaten streak to 10 straight contests, including eight by shutout, with two wins and a scoreless draw last week ... Sophomore **Carlin Scrudato** has secured her seventh shutout of the season, breaking the school record for most shutouts in a season ... The Saints are one shutout away from tying the school record for most shutouts in a season ... Senior **Emily Kellner** scored three goals and had an assist this week, including two goals and an assist against Bethany ... Freshman **Lindsay Dickman** scored her first career goal against Bethany ... **Julianne Brown's** goal against Bethany tied her for the team lead with nine.



## Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Senior F **Jen Pergola** scored four goals, including a hat trick at Bethany, to help W&J post a pair of PAC wins ... The Presidents trailed the Bison by 1-0 and 2-1 first-half margins Tuesday, but Pergola's three goals were the difference ... Pergola's 58 career goals leave her six shy of becoming the all-time goal leader in W&J history ... She also netted the game winner in a 6-0 rout of Thiel Saturday ... Senior MF **Rachel Campbell** and sophomore F **Marie Majkut** added one goal and one assist for the Presidents, while senior F **Toni Lynn Simonini** posted a pair of assists ... Freshman **Madison Manius** also added her first career goal versus the Tomcats ... W&J will honor its six seniors Tuesday prior to the match ... They have posted the most wins by a W&J senior class in school history (37).



## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost a pair of conference contests, both by a score of 2-0 – against Grove City and Westminster ... The Wolverines peppered the Yellow Jackets with 43 shots, managing just one goal in each half ... GKs **Amy Mills** and **Emily Byers** combined to make 14 saves in the losing effort ... In Friday's loss against Westminster, Mills set recent program history as she posted an astounding 33 saves in 84 minutes of play ... Her previous career-high was 12 saves, which she surpassed in the first period with 17 saves ... The Titan-Yellow Jacket game remained tied until the 74th minute when Westminster scored the game's first goal before adding their final tally in the final 30 seconds ... Waynesburg was outshot 87-12 last week.



## Westminster Titans

Westminster clinched first place in the PAC regular season and the top seed and home field advantage for the PAC Tournament with league wins over Thiel (6-0) and Waynesburg (2-0) before suffering a non-conference loss at Carnegie Mellon (1-0) last week ... Sophomore F **Mallory Bugel** posted a hat trick with three goals and added an assist in the first 16 minutes of the Thiel game ... Waynesburg held Westminster scoreless for the first 74:30 Friday, but junior F **Sarah Calderone** and Bugel posted late goals in the win ... Freshman GK **Whitney Griffin** posted her school-record 11th shutout of the season at Waynesburg, breaking the mark of 10 shutouts set by **Nicole Drummond** last year.
