### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany snapped a 13-game losing streak with a 1-0 victory at Thiel on Friday, Oct. 22 ... Freshman **Sara Jackson** scored a goal in the 27th minute to give Bethany the victory, its first since a 2-1 win over Lake Erie on Sept. 4 ... Jackson's goal was also the team's first in six games ... Freshman goalie **Jess Alloggia** had five saves to post her first career shutout ... Bethany was able to get the win despite being out-shot 10-4 ... In the 5-0 loss at W&J, Alloggia had 19 saves.

### **Wash. & Jeff. Presidents**

Junior F **Jen Pergola** scored two goals and added one assist in the first 19 minutes as W&J defeated Bethany, 5-0, on Wednesday ... Pergola started the scoring just over a minute into the match as she broke through the BC defense and scored off a pass from junior MF **Rachel Campbell** ... Junior MF **Toni Lynn Simonini** made it a 2-0 game four minutes later with Pergola assisting ... Pergola scored again off an assist from Simonini at 18:44 and sophomore MF **Stacia Ryder** upped the W&J lead to 4-0 just 34 seconds later ... Freshman MF **Elizabeth Monzi** ended the scoring at the 39:05 mark off an assist from sophomore MF **Rachel Moses** ... Freshman GK **Alicia Denne** totaled two saves to earn her first collegiate shutout.

### **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City extended its win streak to six with a pair of shutouts in PAC play last week ... The Wolverines pulled into first place with a 2-0 victory over Westminster ... **Katie Klingensmith** and **Maia Siber** each scored against the Titans ... Siber has four career goals; two have come against Westminster ... **Kori Koper** stopped 10 shots to record the shutout victory ... **Michelle Novosel** and **Lindsay Bowman** each scored once in Saturday's win at Waynesburg ... Grove City out-shot the Jackets, 27-3 ... Koper recorded her eighth shutout of the season and the team's ninth whitewash overall ... Opponents have yet to score against GCC this month ... Grove City is 22-0-1 in its last 23 October matches.

### **Waynesburg Yellow Jackets**

Waynesburg was on both ends of 2-0 shutouts this week ... First, the Yellow Jackets recorded a 2-0 shutout victory against Thiel Wednesday, before losing 2-0 to Grove City Saturday ... Against the Tomcats, the Yellow Jackets recorded their sixth win of the season, which equaled their win total from the past two seasons combined ... The Jackets have three conference wins this season after failing to post one in each of the last two seasons ... Sophomore **Morgan Smoke** netted two first-half goals in the win over the Tomcats and is second on the team with seven goals and 19 points ... Goalkeeper **Emily Byers** posted six saves for her fourth shutout of the season and made 19 saves on 27 shots in the Jackets loss to the Lady Wolverines.

### **Thiel Tomcats**

The Tomcats fell in a pair of PAC contests last week, losing at Waynesburg 0-2 on Wednesday and at home to Bethany 1-0 on Friday ... Of the 12 Tomcat losses this season, they have failed to score a goal in 10 of them ... Junior GK **Ashleigh Dunsmore** has posted 137 saves (8.6 p/g) this season with a goals-against average of 1.84.

### **Westminster Titans**

The Lady Titans dropped three contests last week, as Westminster dropped its first PAC contest of the season with a 2-0 loss at Grove City ... Westminster then fell twice during a road trip to California, falling at non-league opponents Chapman (3-0) and Claremont-Mudd-Scripps (1-0 in overtime) ... Senior GK **Nicole Drummond** made nine saves against GCC and six saves at Chapman ... The Lady Titans close the season with PAC contests against Waynesburg and Bethany ... Westminster needs to win both contests and hope for a Grove City loss or tie against either Bethany or Thiel for the Lady Titans to earn the top seed at next week's PAC Tournament.
