Westminster College - New Wilmington, Pa. - 2 p.m.

The Titans took a 1-0 lead just 40 seconds into the contest, as freshman F **Sarah Nee (McMurray, PA/Peters Township H.S.)** scored off an assist by senior F **Mallory Bugel (Valencia/Mars H.S.)**. That lead held up until the 62nd minute, when Bugel again assisted on a goal, this time by junior M **Christina Adams (Hubbard, OH/Hubbard H.S.)** for a 2-0 Westminster advantage. Grove City halved the lead in the 71st minute on an unassisted goal by junior F **Stephanie Wild (Carmel, IN/Heritage Christian H.S.)**, but was unable to net the game equalizer. Westminster outshot the Wolverines 17-8 in the contest, while each team managed four corner kicks. Titan sophomore GK **Lindsey Mellott (Cortland, OH/Lakeview H.S.)** stopped four Grove City shots in the win, while her Wolverine junior counterpart **Diana Prigel (Rochester, NY/Greece Arcadia H.S.)** also made four saves.

The top-seeded Saints were stunned by the fourth-seeded Presidents, as W&J junior M **Beth Reefer (Butler, Pa./Slippery Rock)** scored the game's only goals with nine minutes remaining to eliminate Thomas More from the tournament. The Saints attempted to clear a W&J corner kick, but the ball deflected off the back of a TMC defender and Reefer converted the goal. W&J junior GK **Jackie Foltz (Port Royal, Pa./Juniata H.S.)** made three saves to earn the shutout in goal for the Presidents.

Westminster advances on penalty kicks - 3-2

Westminster College - New Wilmington, Pa. - 1 p.m.

The Titans captured their second consecutive PAC women's soccer title and fifth in the past six years with a thrilling penalty kick victory over upset-minded Washington & Jefferson. After a scoreless opening half, the Presidents opened the scoring in the 69th minute, when junior M **Madison Manius (Coraopolis, PA/Montour H.S.)** collected a loose ball in the Westminster box and headed home the score for a 1-0 lead. Westminster rallied to tie the score 1-1 in the 77th minute, as junior D **Jessi Losteter (Jefferson Hills, PA/Thomas Jefferson H.S.)** scored off assists by senior M **Kait Etzel-Hardman (Pittsburgh, PA/Baldwin H.S.)** and junior M **Christina Adams (Hubbard, OH/Hubbard H.S.)**. The Titans outshot the Presidents 6-1 in the two overtime periods, but were unable to break the tie. Tied 1-1 through three rounds of the penalty kick shootout, Westminster took control when W&J missed high, followed by Titan senior D **Kristen Martin (Pittsburgh/North Allegheny H.S.)** scoring for a 2-1 WC advantage. In the final round, senior F **Marie Majkut (Honolulu, HI/Punahou H.S.)** scored to tie the count at 2-2, only to see Titan freshman F **Sarah Nee (McMurray, PA/Peters Township H.S.)** find the back of the net on the final penalty kick to give Westminster the win. The Titans outshot W&J 23-13 and held a 12-5 advantage in corner kicks. Westminster sophomore GK **Lindsey Mellott (Cortland, OH/Lakeview H.S.)** made five saves, while President junior GK **Jackie Foltz (Port Royal, PA/Juniata H.S.)** stopped eight shots in the loss.
