### **LINDSAY HOSLER Grove City College**

Sophomore - #4 singles/#2 doubles

## PAC WOMEN'S TENNIS NOTES

### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison finished up the regular season last week with a 8-1 loss at Grove City on Thursday, Oct. 14 ... The lone Bison winner was the first doubles team of **Katie Navarra** and **Hillary Norman**, who defeated the Wolverines, 8-6 ... Navarra played tough in first singles but narrowly lost, 4-6, 5-7, while Norman fell in a hard-fought match at second singles, 3-6, 6-7 (1-7) ... The Bison will participate in the PAC Championships on Saturday, Oct. 23.

### **Wash. & Jeff. Presidents**

Washington & Jefferson dropped a 9-0 decision to defending PAC Champion Grove City on Monday, but bounced back with its second 9-0 victory over Thiel this season ... The Presidents won five of six singles matches in straight sets and outpointed Thiel, 24-1, in doubles play ... Seniors **Terra Naviglia** and **Katy Petousis** posted 6-1, 6-0 victories at No. 2 and No. 4 singles, respectively ... Senior **Cassandra NiCastro** also had a 6-1, 6-1 win at No. 5 singles ... The W&J-Grove City match scheduled for Monday, October 18<sup>th</sup> has been pushed back to Wednesday at 3:00 pm at the Janet L. Swanson Tennis Courts.

### **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City reached the 10-win mark for the first time since 1999 with three wins last week ... Against Washington and Jefferson, senior **Megan Hulick** and junior **Julie Crewson** each earned two wins while the doubles teams of **Julie Bellissimo-Bethany Shaffer** and **Jennifer Gifford-Emily Russell** each earned their first win of 2004 ... Crewson, Hulick, **Lindsay Hosler**, **Nicole Leasure** and **Kristin McNally** all earned two wins against Waynesburg ... Hosler, Leasure and McNally all picked up two wins at Bethany Thursday ... Grove City owns 76 straight wins against PAC foes ... The Wolverines will close the dual-match portion of the season Wednesday at Washington and Jefferson.

### **Waynesburg Yellow Jackets**

The Waynesburg College women's tennis team's regular season ended on a sore note, as it lost 9-0 to 17-time reigning conference champion Grove City ... No Yellow Jacket player was able to force a third set in singles play, while in doubles no Jacket tandem earned more than two games ... Freshman **Katie Kravits** lost in straight sets, 6-3, 6-1, in the season finale, but finished the regular season with a team-high 12 singles victories after posting an 11-3 record at No. 2 singles ... Sophomore **Jenn Knight** finished second on the team in singles victories with seven, and teamed with classmate **Beth Conlon** for a team-high seven doubles victories, all of which were at the No. 2 seed.

### **Thiel Tomcats**

The Tomcats dropped all three of their matches last week, losing at home to Penn State Altoona 9-0 on Monday before falling on the road to Penn State Behrend (0-9) on Wednesday and W&J (0-9) on Thursday ... The regular season for Thiel's women's tennis team is complete and the Tomcats will participate in the PAC Championships this weekend at the Pennbriar Fitness & Racquet Club in Erie.

### **Westminster Titans**

Westminster closed the 2004 regular season by splitting a pair of non-league contests, falling at Penn State-Behrend 6-3 before closing with a 6-3 home win over NAIA member St. Vincent ... Freshman **Christina Commisso** was the team's lone double-winner against Behrend ... Commisso captured #6 singles, while teaming with classmate **Dana Larson** for a win at #2 doubles ... Senior **Amy Browell** was also victorious at #5 singles ... Westminster's three seniors were all double winners vs. SVC ... **Amy Caliguiri** won at #1 singles and #1 doubles with sophomore **Sara Belsito** ... She was joined by the duo of **Bethany Grubbs** and Browell, which teamed at #3 doubles while adding wins at #4 and #5 singles, respectively.
